



PROCEDURE TO OBTAIN AND REGISTER A NEW 16FT SKIFF CARBON MAST

1. Choose a supplier of your choice.
2. Check the supplier has a Supplier Agreement with the Australian 16ft Skiff Association in place. (a) If an agreement is in place – order your new mast / masts. (b) If no agreement is in place – have your supplier contact the Australian 16ft Skiff Association by email (rwretail@bigpond.net.au) or by phone (Rob – 0418 191 010) to have an agreement issued.
3. On receipt of your new mast / masts – after rigging (complete with all blocks, wires, turnbuckles, adjusters, halyards, etc) it needs to be presented to your club / zone measurer. After the measurer is happy the mast complies with the class rules, a registration sticker will be applied to the new mast around the gooseneck area. This will be entered into a national class registry.
4. For the purpose of persons who wish to build their own carbon mast, a supply agreement is not required. The completed rigged mast needs only to be presented to your club / zone measurer for measuring and registration.
