 - pin mark was taken up early;
 - no Outer Towra mark had been laid for the 13's (one was finally laid just in time);
 - starter's boat ("Bill Riley") broke down during the race, meaning that an alternative finish boat had to be found quickly and this was in position at the very last minute; and
 - there was confusion at the finish because the finish boat had been moored on the wrong side of the finish mark.

Michael to speak with Manly/St George Commodore Grant Windsham to see what can be done in future years to avoid these problems which were partly due to the fact that there was a very small band of dedicated (but ageing) volunteers at the St George Club.
