# **AUSTRALIAN ASSOCIATION**

- 1. <u>Skiff spare parts</u> still proceeding. They have agreed to add a 10% fee for most parts to help recover the administrative cost of purchasing those parts.
- 2. <u>Possible engagement of marketing company</u> the ASSA acknowledges that it needs to identify what we want as an Association:
  - > Sponsorship money target (possibly a return on investment matrix eg. spend \$12,000 with BANG and receive \$250,000 in sponsorship money)
  - ➤ How many new skiffs on the water?
  - Are we marketing to people outside the sport?
  - The ASSA has the potential to contact large groups of people this includes sailors and members of the skiff clubs Belmont have 24,000 club members.
  - Possible parameters for BANG:
    - > \$250,000 in sponsorship
    - ➤ Double the amount of 16ft Skiff registrations
    - ➤ Double the amount of 13ft Skiff registrations.
- 3. <u>Auditor</u> Mike Birrell has agreed to audit financial statements and complete an Audit Report for free.
- 4. <u>Australian Championships</u> season 2018/19 Darling Point Sailing Squadron has expressed an interest in hosting the 2018/19 National Titles.

- 3. <u>Heat 3 of the NSW 13ft Skiff State Championship</u> was started on Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> November 2016 at Middle Harbour at 12:20pm, however, the race had to be abandoned after about 20 minutes sailing due to very patchy winds. Boats returned to the starting area, but conditions did not improve after one hour, so the race was postponed until 2:40pm. The heat (Ht 3) was subsequently postponed, along with Heat 4, with no further racing for the day at 2:20pm after the breeze freshened from the West-North-West at 15-32 knots.
- 4. Resail of Heats 3 and 4 feedback was sought from competitors on possible resail dates. One option was to hold in conjunction with Australian Championships, another was to hold at Manly later in the season. There was no clear consensus, so the matter was discussed at this meeting and it was decided to reschedule both races for Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> February 2017 at Manly.

5. <u>Prizemoney for 13ft Skiff States</u> - it was agreed to allocate \$600 in prizemoney for the overall results of the State Championships on both scratch and handicap as follows:
