Presidents Report 2015/16

The 2015-16 season was a success for QSSA on many levels. Thanks to the QSSA committee, some dedicated members and the three Qld skiff clubs we managed to host a successful, fun and friendly national title in Hervey Bay. Qld had the best representation at a national title in many years in both the 16 and 13 fleets also achieving some of the best results seen by Qld crews in a long time. It was great to have a 16 in the top 5 with the RW crew finishing 4th on scratch and two 13's in the top 5 with Albert Smith Signs finishing 3rd and Sign Manager finishing 5th. We must also thank the sponsors that supported the title and helped to make it a financially viable event. Without them, hosting a national title would not be possible and we need to make sure we continue to support these businesses.

This year's training day for the 16ft and 13ft skiffs brought multiple 16ft skiff national champion Ricky Bridge to Qld. Ricky brought a different perspective and skill set to coaching, being one of the best skiff crew's in the country. The crews in attendance got a lot out of the weekend. We must thank Ricky for kindly donating time out of his busy schedule to develop our sailors. Numbers for the 16's were down but the 13's attendance was up and highlighted that we perhaps need to reassess the format and aims of our training initiatives.

The 13ft skiff fleet continued to develop into a highly competitive fleet with club racing and regatta results being close. By the end of the season we saw some of the older sailors transition into the 16ft class and some new sailors joining the 13 fleet in their place. This is thanks to a number of factors including the efforts of some of our members at bringing people into the class and the generosity of others to lend their boats to potential newcomers. It reinforces how important 13ft skiffs are to our association and its future. Racing in the 16ft fleet was very competitive at both clubs and there were some new faces in the fleet which is always a promising sign. Congratulation to the RW team who became Qld's first winners of the Australian Sprint Championships. This not only shows the rest of our fleet what can be achieved but also indicates Qld is becoming more competitive in the national fleet.

We recently had our first strategic planning workshop and made a good start on setting the goals and vision for our future. Thanks to Malcom Thorburn for suggesting the initiative and for kindly facilitating the workshops. It builds on the good work the association has been doing in recent years and will help ensure we are all working together to achieve our goals. It's great that as a group we are willing to try different things and donate our time to grow and develop our class. We also put a display in the boat show this August in order to promote the class and generate some public interest. The outcomes of this will be better known in the coming months but we have seen some increased social media activity and there appeared to be some interest in the learn to sail flyers we had on display. Thanks to Keith and Dan for allowing us to display their boats and thanks to the members who donated their time over the 3 days. Moving forward it's important to keep the ideas and suggestions coming but we would also like to have more people help put them into action.

Thank you to the QSSA committee – Lauren and Simon Walker and Jennifer Hawgood for your efforts this past season. Thank you to the members that have helped throughout the year. A big thank you must go to both DPSS, BSS and MSC who's support helped make the season the success it was.
