10.1. SG's letter to ASSA

PH explained actions being made by ASSA to improve measurement at Nationals by
utilising a spreadsheet with boat's information including sails registered and photos of
lead correctors (to be provided by club/State measurers). This will allow for easy
auditing of boats throughout the Nationals and transparency regarding what
correctors are installed in each boat and how they are secured.

10.3. Strategic Planning

 - Competition against 13s and 16s: 12ft, 14ft, 18ft skiffs and 49ers.
 - KH to approach Daniel Jack to manage the development of a high performance plan or possibly hold a meeting with those interested in a high performance group to gather interest and find someone to take on the role to manage it.
 - LG to approach Peter Robba to assist with developing a mentoring and support program for 13s.
 - Reviewing past sailors who might be interested in sailing skiffs again.
 - Possible River and Bay series as a QSSA event to increase club race numbers and close competition:
 - Approach a sponsor
 - Include 13s in the regattas
 - 3 races at each club
 - QSSA to contact DPSS and BSS to find available dates to run a Bay series and River Series, also email DPSS regarding an opening day availability.
 - Make a flyer with the QSSA events once the calendar is set to create easy access to information.
