- 10.1. Report from the Nationals
 - Still have 33 hats, 17 shirts
 - May be able to see some cheap at Easter given there will be a different crowd there.
 May also be able to use as prizes, give to future skiffies at DPSS presentation etc.
 - left-over Ronstan gear (start watch, 2 bags, gloves and 2 shirts)

 the club presentation nights. KH to approach clubs, potentially suggest to DPSS that

- money will go towards 13s training day in May.
- MSC still owe QSSA money from nationals. KH suggested that we meet with them at Easter to reconcile and finalise.
- 10.2. Pennants are done and need to be picked up from Springwood. Slightly smaller than older pennants but look the same. 4 years worth for 16s and 13s \$560.
- 10.3. KH has looked at quotes for a set of scales for QSSA. \$225 for a set of hanging digital scales.
 - PH: would be a good asset for QSSA to have people could weigh boats, would be a good chance to have every one on same page.
 - PH: will need to calibrate each year.
 - KH can get a test weight to check that it is accurate at start of each season, only
 calibrate if needed.
 - KH proposes that all boats are weighed at start of season. Lead is marked.
 Opportunities to re-weigh and remove lead with the official measurer during the season as required.
 - Will be discussed at the next meeting and a decision made.
- 10.4. 16ft skiff training day unsure of format this year and whether it is worth doing again (considering cost vs benefits)
 - PH could consider a local coach this year.
 - KH call for ideas on who to approach?
 - JA suggested using videos video of yourself sailing, see where to improve.
 - PH there are some video resources on YouTube.
 - LG suggested ensuring more experienced skiff sailors can get in with the younger sailors to impart their experience and wisdom.
- 10.5. 13ft Skiffs Update
 - Flyer has been finalised
 - a number of 13s in NSW are up for sale; a few have sold down there
 - a few parents down there want to build new ones
 - Middle Harbour want 5 new 13s to kick off their fleet
 - Vicky has a skype meeting on the 29th or 30th with Clint, Wasso, Andrew and Lisa to discuss a way forward for 13s in both states. Want to minimise the cost of 13s hoping to drop from \$19K to \$14K to be competitive with 29ers. Vicky will provide an update next meeting.
 - DPSS have nominated a weekend to get all 13s down here to get some young kids into them try a 13 day on Saturday 28th May. Sunday 29th May would be training for current 13s (Presentation is 28th May). Some talk that Cameron McDonald may be interested in assisting with training; also hoping to get Matt Stena involved. DPSS are organising. Will keep QSSA in the loop and let us know what involvement / assistance is required.
 - RQ is pushing for 29ers and 13s to work together.
 - o VP will be good to have a race in a bigger fleet before the nationals.
 - KH: will e-mail Brady (RQ coach, organises 29ers down there) so that it is formalised.
- 10.6. LW: Mal Thorburn has suggested strategic planning session goal setting and action plan to set direction for upcoming season and hopefully reduce work for committee and members throughout the season. He has offered to facilitate.
 - All agreed this was a good idea, will consider when to do this, possibly next meeting when it is quiet.
 - Will check with Mal to determine a date, possibly next meeting.
